Japan Post Co., Ltd.'s near-term greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reduction targets validated by the SBTi

Japan Post Co., Ltd. announces that its near-term science-based emissions reduction targets have been validated by the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi*).

SBT certification is granted by the SBTi to confirm that a company's GHG emissions reduction targets are scientifically grounded and aligned with the level required by the Paris Agreement.

As part of its commitment to achieving carbon neutrality by 2050, the Japan Post Group has set a GHG emissions reduction target for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2031 as an interim milestone. Building on this certification, Japan Post will further strengthen its efforts to reduce total GHG emissions, including emissions across its value chain (Scope1~3).



■ GHG emissions reduction targets validated by the SBTi

Scope1・Scope2	34.1% reduction by the fiscal year ending March 31, 2031 (compared to the fiscal year ended March 31, 2024)
Scope3	17.5% reduction by the fiscal year ending March 31, 2031 (compared to the fiscal year ended March 31, 2024) *Target categories: Category 1 (Purchased goods and services) and Category 4 (Upstream transportation and distribution)

Scope 1: Direct GHG emissions from a company's own operations, including fuel combustion and other sources.

Scope 2: Indirect GHG emissions from purchased electricity and other supplied energy.

Scope 3: GHG emissions across the company's value chain, classified into 15 activity-based categories.

Notes:

The Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) is a global corporate climate action organization that promotes and independently validates science-based GHG emissions reduction targets aligned with the goals of the Paris Agreement and the latest climate science. The initiative is a collaboration between CDP, the United Nations Global Compact (UNGC), the World Resources Institute (WRI), and the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF).
